Pedro Cardigos has collaborated with ISDA since 1999, initially as a consultant of the *ISDA 1999 Collateral Review*, subsequently authoring the *ISDA Collateral Opinion* for Portugal and, more recently, the *ISDA Clearing Member Reliance Opinion*. Mr. Cardigos is also the outside legal counsel for the derivative and financial instruments areas of the Portuguese Debt Agency (IGCP) since 1996 and, has assisted the Ministry of Finance, public sector companies, the Regional Government of Madeira and regional sector companies in issues and disputes in the areas of derivatives and financial instruments.

Pedro Cardigos holds a law degree from the *Faculdade de Ciências Humanas da Universidade Católica* (1987) and a post-graduate degree on Public International Law from the *Faculdade de Direito da Universidade de São Paulo - Brazil* (1988) and a master degree (LLM) in *American Studies* from *ITT- Chicago-Kent School of Law* (1999).
